
Can I have my say?






What is a Child Protection **Conference**?

A Child Protection Conference is a special meeting if people have a worry about how things are for you and your family. They will talk about what they can do to help keep you safe.







What happens at the meeting?

In the meeting they will talk about:

- What is happening for you and your family and why there is a worry that things may not be safe for you
- What problems you and your family might be having.
- Finding the best ways to keep you safe and help your family

Who will be at the meeting?

You may know some people but not everyone who goes to the meeting. They will all be people wanting to make things better so you are safer. These may include:

- Someone to organise the meeting Your parents or carers
- Your social worker
- Someone from your school
- A doctor or nurse
- A health visitor
- A police officer
- Other people who

have worked with you or your parents or carers
